Final Proposals of the workshop 2.-Sexuality. Women's Rights to decide on their bodies. Pleasant. Sex Education in Schools. Anti-Conception and Abortion. (mesa 2)

1.- Demand that meet the sexual and reproductive rights of girls, children, adolescents and women adjusting to the reality of each country.

2 .- Require gender and sexual diversity at all levels of education, formal and informal, public and private. . Sex Education to decide. "

3 .- Require compliance with national and international legislation on women's human rights with emphasis on sexual and reproductive rights also promote legislation in the countries where there is not.

4 .- Sex education to decide, legal contraception, safe, accessible, free, and legal abortion, safe and free in all public health systems not to die.

5 .- Demystifying sexuality to promote healthy sexual education to prevent sexual abuse in children and adolescents.

6 .- Require gender mainstreaming in all legislation and public policy.
7 .- We declare our full solidarity with all victims of violence, especially with Romina Tejerina (Jujuy, Argentina). Imprisonment for all rapists.
8.-demand decriminalization and legalization of abortion for any reason.

9.- To promote activities in each country the 28 of September as the International Day of Women's Health.

10 .- Fight to combat the breeding institutions and patriarchal capitalist system of oppression and appropriation of women's bodies such as the bourgeois state, church and family as an institution.

All the workshop regrets the absence of Colombia, stranded by the lack of visa on the border with Venezuela and demand that they investigate the cause for which they could not leave or enter Colombia to Venezuela. Also repudiate that Afghan women did not get visas for other countries to attend the conference.

CONCLUSIONS

• Against the double oppression, understanding its origins economic, political and social we intend to encourage women's movements in our countries to take in their hands to fight for their rights aimed at their release.

• That the economic crisis generated whom paid and not the people who suffer.

Failure to pay foreign debts incurred by dictatorships unfair.

• We agree to get drafted in the National Meeting of Argentine women: Sex Education To decide Abort and No Contraceptives for Legal Abortion for not dying. Demanding that the 3 instances are guaranteed by the state without the interference of the Church. • We express our solidarity with the social struggles and social activists who are persecuted for participating in this: No to the criminalization of social protest.

• Separation of Church and State does not impact on the policies themselves.
