Agreements.

- 1)- That woman should have the right to equal pay for equal work, ensuring a dignified life.
- 2)- That the time for women to retire is 25 years of service, but it counts for age or respecting each country's labor market, women age 55 and men at age 60.
- 3 .- Social Security for all workers, while also recognizing the work of the home as part of the work that must be paid.
- 4 .- No dismissals and suspensions, that the crisis pay the capitalist, not the meek and humble.
- 5 .- demand job security. Not contracting, outsourcing, informal work.
- 6 .- The daily working time is of 06 hours instead of 8 hours, without reducing wages, to provide improvements to the quality of life and share the working family.
- 7.-It is proposed nursery building in the workplace for women, also the extension of maternity leave.
- 8 .- To form unions that work on behalf of women in every country, bearing in mind the proletarian internationalism.
- 9 .- Organization of Communities and women's movements as a force that drives the progressive consolidation of socialism.
- 10 .- Attendance to illness.
- 11 .- resounding rejection of the criminalization of social struggle.
- 12 .- Establishment of the Global Communications Network to strengthen security ties. In this way it is necessary to give greater relace the 8th of March, 1 May and 25 November.
