1. We declare solidarity with the right of the Libyan people autodeterminacion and reject every military occupation and foreign interference attack against the Libyan people.

6. campaigns to encourage each country to decriminalize abortion "deciding sexual education, contraceptives and abortion, legal abortion to avoid death.
7. In each country to promote women's national meetings to ensure maximum political participation of women in relation to issues of class and gender.
8. Replicate in each country at national level start participating countries, the World Conference of grassroots women.
 - broad-based coordination to national status in the country.
 - Address where delegations have collective participation in diversity and inclusive as political, social, cultural, inter alia, by the struggle and class unity.

Express our solidarity for women's movements as Colombians for peace and the movement against the premises of the military bases of North American imperialism in Colombia, which destabilize peace in the south-south, as well as provide support to Senator Piedad Cordoba.

We declare ourselves anti-patriarchal, assuming that the gender issue can not be secondary to the struggle against capitalism, as this is maintained over the domination that has long been practicing longer patriarchy, reinforcing the subjugation of women and of those who leave male pattern.

Assuming that patriarchy is an obstacle to effective political participation of women and therefore refuse:

The reduction of women's political participation to an issue of shares within the system of power, without a questioning of what it has to re ignoring oppressive and exploitative unequal power relations established by the patriarchal system.

The frequent manipulation of grassroots women by political parties and organizations, in order to ensure a mass mobilization, with no real active active participation and empowerment of women.

The lack of reflection or the abandonment of feminist demands by women who reach positions of responsibility in institutions, political parties or organizations.

Patriarchal power relations that dominate our daily lives that force women to have to assume a triple or even quadruple workday affecting our political participation.

Create spaces for reflection and collective construction of gender and patriarchy in our parties, organizations, groups addressing the issue in its complexity, from the public to the personal ("revolution in the streets, houses and beds).

Creating spaces for coordination and exchange of materials and experiences through a blog or website on the issues.

Continue massifying sociopolitical training for women to acquire awareness of class struggle, recognizing and eradicating domestic compliance work, cultural and social.
