As before, each country has 3 delegates, but the conference is open to all interested women (and men). **Let us ensure together that all age groups are represented in the delegations.** For the 5th topic of the agenda (young women) we also suggest delegations of three women per country.

At the second European Conference in Amsterdam we have decided to increase the mobilization of young women and girls. We want to make this 3rd Conference an attractive event for the youth, but we count on you to share your ideas and experiences.

A further important aim of this conference is to mobilize **delegates of new countries**. Please all contribute to this aim!

On **Saturday night** there is a 'Fête' and we want to get to know one another better. We invite you to bring a cultural contribution from your country (song, dance, music, handicrafts etc.)

On Sunday morning the 9th of February a **city walk through Paris** is planned. The theme is: 'Paris and its revolutionary history'.

Afterwards there will be a lunch in the hall of our Turkish and Kurdish friends of the SKB (Socialist Women) in Paris.

It is possible and even desirable to already come to the conference on Friday night.

For **accommodation** there is the possibility to stay in a nearby hotel for approximately 20 Euro per night in 3 or 4 bed-rooms. But there are also a limited number of places at 'host families' for 10 to 15 Euro. In a short time you will receive more information.

The **conference costs** itself are 30 Euro per participant. (Food and drinks 15 Euro. Conference fee 15 Euro. The conference fee is used, for example, to rent a translation system.)

Each participant is responsible for their own travel costs and the afternoon meal on Sunday will cost about 5 Euro.
