### I. Connections

The World Women's Conference of grass roots women is an international movement of women which plays an important role in mobilizing grass roots women and their organizations for defending women's rights given the various crises, that hit women with full force(due to poverty, unemployment, migration, climate change, violence based on sex, armed conflicts, wars e.g...)

The Africa Conference took place in Bamako from 23 to 25 May 2017. This meeting of African grass roots women is a logical consequence of the first meeting in Lomé which ran from 10th to 14th July 2012, in order to strengthen the movement on that continent. It took place with delegates from four African countries and with two German representatives of the worldwide women's movement.

# 1. Contents

#### 1.1. General content

The general discussion at the Africa Conference of grass roots women involved the rights of women in connection with the armed conflicts and the refugee crisis.

#### 1.2. The specific content

Specific topics are the following:

\* To contribute to knowledge and changes of the problems of African women in armed conflicts, radicalization and the refugee crisis. To contribute to the change, the knowledge of alternative answers to the problems which the African women are contronted with in the situation of armed conflicts, of radicalization and the refuge crisis.

\* Let us strengthen an environmental change, exchange experiences about our life conditions with grass roots women from Africa and from different continents and let us find answers.

\* Working out an action plan and a resolution for the African grass roots women in close connection with grass roots women from all over the world, at the end of the meeting in Bamako.

\* Let us organize more frequent exchange in Africa among the African members

\* Initiating permanent actions, which will give the African delegates an important financial contribution for the process

### 2. Achieved results

\* Designing a Facebook account

\* Organizing an African week once a year in Europe – the first will take place in October 2017 in Germany.

### These new permanent activities

\* Suggesting conferences and debates

\* Supporting a film and publishing a book about the African organizations

\* Selling local products and crafts from all different regions with the contribution of 5% per country to the World Women's Conference

\* Release to return to support the of local women's organizations

\* Finding of agriculturally processed products from different regions of Africa as a general activity of grass roots women

### II Course

The conference started at 10 o'clock in the conference room at the "Centre Amadou Hampathé Ba" in Bamako, district Missira.

The opening ceremony was initiated by the coordinator of the "Association Routes du Sud" " Awa Meité van Til. She welcomed all delegations (African and German) as well as different participators of various Malian local organizations.

She then gave the floor to all the present delegates for presenting themselves with their structures and activities.

After these greeting words visitors could present themselves- Here their names to keep them in mind:

\* Suse BADER, Coordinator of Europe for the World Women's Movement, accompanied by Elvira Duerr, translator for French/German.

The present structure of the grass roots women were presented; all participants actively participated in the debates and all focused on their various main interests. The various statements resulted in women having a challenge to stand up together.

A hospitable lunch break with about 40 Malian grass roots woman took place. Work for the delegates restarted at 3 o'clock p.m. about the organizational structures in Germany as well as in Europe. This completed the activities of the first day. The second day of the conference was meant as a framework for the African delegates to discuss the prospects of the African movement. It focused on proposals of how the movement can be independent. The solutions corresponding to the order they were mentioned.

### Conclusion

The second Africa Conference of grass roots women has proved to be an important step towards the revival of the African movement.

The new perspectives resulting from this are voluntariness and mobilization without absence of the coordinators who will be really present.
